In the reference cited 1st, the school was granted No Objection Certificate for its affiliation with the Central Board of Secondary Education with Initial Recognition upto 25.01.2020.

2. In the reference cited 2nd, under the provisions of Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act 2009, Sec 18, read as follows:-

“No School, other than a school established, owned or controlled by the appropriate Government or the local authority, shall, after the commencement of this Act, be established or function, without obtaining a certificate of recognition from such authority, by making an application in such form and manner, as may be prescribed.”

3. In the reference cited 3rd, the Government issued G.O vide G.O.(Ms)No.144, School Education (GE) Department dated 18.09.2014 making it mandatory for Schools affiliated to boards other than Secondary / Higher Secondary Boards of the State Government to get necessary recognition from the Director of School Education.

With reference to the application received from the School Management and school Inspection duly caused on 21.03.2022 and with reference to the G.O.8th read above and Proceedings of Commissioner of School Education 9th read above renewal of Recognition is hereby accorded to AKARA WORLD SCHOOL, No.1 UDAYANPATTI ROAD, UDAYANPATTI, K.K.NAGAR, POST, TIRUCHIRAPPALLI DT – 620 021 (Survey No.T.S.No.25)for Classes LKG to XI Std for the period of 26.01.2020 to 16.10.2022

The recognition Code Number allotted to your school- 23-S-0006-0120

The UDISE Code Number 33150401110

The above recognition is subject to the following conditions:-

- (1) The temporary recognition accorded to the school is valid upto 16.06.2022 and is to be renewed at an interval of every three years.
- (2) The School shall abide by the provisions of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 and the Tamil Nadu Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2011.
- (3) The School shall admit in pre-school / class I to the extent of 25% of the strength in each class, children belonging to Weaker Section and Disadvantaged Group in the neighbourhood and provide free and compulsory elementary education till its completion.
- (4) The School shall maintain a separate bank account for the purpose of reimbursement.
- (5) The School shall not collect any capitation fee and subject the child or his or her parent or guardian to any screening procedure.
- (6) The School shall not deny admission to any child, -
 - (a) For lack of age proof if such admission is sought subsequent to the extended period prescribed for admission.
 - (b) On the ground of religion, caste or race, place of birth or any of them.
- (7) The School shall ensure that,-
 - (i) No child admitted shall be held back in any class or expelled from School till the completion of elementary education in a school;
 - (ii) No child shall be subjected to physical punishment or mental harassment.
 - (iii) No child is required to pass any board examination till the completion of elementary education;
 - (iv) Every child completing elementary education shall be awarded a certificate as laid down under rule 21.
 - (v) Inclusion of students with disabilities / special needs as per provision of the Act.

- (vi) The teachers are recruited with minimum qualifications as laid under section 23(1) of the Act:
Provided that the teachers who, at the commencement of this Act do not possess minimum qualifications shall acquire such minimum qualifications within a period of 5 years;
- (vii) The teacher performs his duties specified under sub-section (1) of section 24 of the Act; and
- (viii) The teacher shall not engage himself for private teaching activities.
- (xi) The School shall follow the basic requirements and syllabus on the basis of curriculum laid down by Appropriate authority.
- (x) The School shall maintain the standards and norms as specified in section 19 of the Act
- (xi) No unrecognized classes shall run within the premises of the school or outside in the name of School.
- (xii) The School building or other structures and the grounds are used only for the purposes of education and skill development.
- (xiii) The School is run by a society registered under the Tamil Nadu Societies Registration Act, 1975 (Tamil Nadu Act 27 of 1975), or a public trust constituted under any law for the time being in force;
- (xiv) The School is not run for profit to any individual, group or association of individuals or any other persons;
- (xv) The accounts should be audited and certified by a Chartered Accountant and proper accounts statements should be prepared. A copy each of the Statements of Accounts should be sent every year to the competent Authority granting recognition.
- (xvi) The recognition Code Number shall be quoted for any correspondence with the competent authority.
- (xvii) The School shall furnish such reports and information as may be required by the competent authority from time to time and shall comply with such instructions of the State Government or the competent authority as may be issued to secure the continued fulfilment of the condition of recognition or the removal of deficiencies in working of the School;

- B.(1)** Tamil shall be taught as a subject from in Standards I to IX in all schools notified under sub clause (iv) of clause (e) of section 2 of the Tamil Nadu Tamil Learning Act, 2006 (Tamil Nadu Act 13 of 2006) in a phased manner commencing from the Academic year 2015-2016 for standard I, from the academic year 2016-2017 for standard I and II and shall be extended up to standard IX in a like manner as ordered in a reference (4) cited.

C.(1) The School Management shall ensure renewal of the following Certificates as per the due dates.

- (i) License permitting the use of the School building as Public Building under The Tamil Nadu Buildings (Licensing) Act, 1965 (Tamil Nadu Act XIII of 1965);
 - (ii) Structural Stability Certificate for the school building issued by the Executive Engineers of the Public Works Department or from the Chartered Engineers in the panel of qualified and Registered Engineers maintained by the District Collectors in accordance with the Tamil Nadu Public Buildings (Licensing) Act, 1965;
 - (iii) Sanitary and Hygiene Certificate issued by the Health Officer of the locality and;
 - (iv) No Objection Certificate obtained from the Station Officer (Fire and Rescue) in the area, where the School is situated;
9. School should not be conducting classes on all public holidays or any holiday declared by the government
 10. School management should abide by the direction given by The District Collector declaring holiday for schools on account of imminent incessant rains or other looming disaster forecast or local holidays declared under Negotiable Instruments Act 1881.
 11. The school management should not change or alter its lease deed registered for school purpose without obtaining prior approval from the competent authority of school education department
 12. The school management should not alter or construct any further buildings in its premises without obtaining building plan approval from the competent authority.
 13. The Educational Agency shall abide by the provisions contained in the following safety and security related government orders and guidelines.
 - G.O.No:131 SED Dated: 10.08.2006
 - G.O.No:270 SED Dated: 22.10.2012
 - G.O.No:33 SED Dated: 07.03.2013
 - School safety policy 2016 – National Disaster Management Agency
 - NCPCR guidelines - Manual on Safety and Security of Children in Schools.
 - Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Protection and Redressal) Act 2013.
 - Tami Nadu Combined Development and Building Rules 2019.
 - Tamil Nadu Motors Vehicle (Regulation and Control of School Buses) Special Rules, 2012
 14. School management should strictly comply with the norms stipulated for conducting online classes vide G.O.No:65 SED Dated: 29.07.2020 and other subsequent circulars issued from time-to-time in this regard.
 15. School management should not be issuing transfer certificate forcefully to any student on account of student's academic performance and should not indulge in compelling the student to take the board examination as a private candidate.
 16. School management should not be withholding transfer certificate in terminal classes or in any other classes for non-payment of fees as it might cause irreparable damage and severely harm the higher education prospects of the child and pendency of fee payment can be separately tracked with the parent concerned. The School management should take in to cognizance the direction given by The Hon'ble Madurai Bench of Madras High court in its judgment in W.P.No.9242/2017 & 9243/2017 dated: 18.05.2017 wherein it has been categorically stated that "No school has any authority to deny the issuance of the transfer certificates and other

documents... "If at all there exists any legitimate claims against the parents, the school has to move the civil court for realizing the same, but the future of the children should not be held to ransom on this score".

17. School management should strictly abide by the NCPCR guidelines that **"No child should be harassed/neglected/discriminated due to any non-agreement or conflict between parents and the school or other educational institution catering to children till the age of 18 years. Such disagreements should be addressed only between the parents and school/educational institution without involving the child in any manner"**.
18. The management shall enter into an agreement with all the staff in the form prescribed by the CBSE.
19. The school management should not be retaining the original educational qualification certificates of all its staff in school.
20. The certificates of recognition issued by the department shall be subject to the fulfilment of deficiencies if any pointed out by the department at any Stage/time. The management shall rectify the deficiencies pointed out in infrastructure or Administration by the authorities. The Management shall apply for renewal of recognition three months prior to the date of the next renewal.
21. The School Management should be strictly adhering to all the provisions stipulated in CBSE Affiliation By-Laws 2018 and the management shall also follow the directions issued by the Government from time to time keeping in view of the safety and security of the children and the overall administration of the School.
22. The school affiliated to **Central Board of Secondary Education** is not entitled to seek affiliation to any other Board without obtaining prior permission of the State Government.
23. The recognition shall be withdrawn if any contravention of the provisions of the Act, Rules or the conditions of recognition are found and proved.
24. All the documents should be obtained from School Authority in the name of above said school.
25. **In addition to the above conditions, the school management should specifically rectify the queries stated under**
 - i The School Management should be submitting the exact building completion details in sq.mts. from the Local body and chartered Engineer out of the proposed total built up area approved in the DTCP Plan Approval. Time extension given by the local body for the completion of the pending 2nd floor structure to be constructed as per plan approval should also be submitted to this office.
 - ii Deviations in the constructed structure from the DTCP Plan approval is unacceptable and space meant for lobby being converted into classrooms and other purposes should be used for its original purpose.
 - iii **Certificate of Land from Tahsildar have to be obtained.**
 - iv Glass and Wooden Partitions bifurcating classrooms should be replaced with proper walls satisfying adequate stipulated dimensions for each classrooms.
 - v **Slide like Aluminium cabin partition in class rooms should be done away and replaced with proper walls and moreover stability certificate should be given to the present arrangement till the replacement of the partition with walls.**

- vi **The School Management should be reconsidering the Higher Secondary admissions as the school is not having sufficient number of classrooms as per the plan approval besides failing to satisfy the requisite Labs, Library, Multipurpose Hall and Maths Lab etc.,**
- vii **School should not enroll students more than its accommodating capacity so as to avoid children being packed like sardines causing cheek by jowl congestion.**
- viii Labs in adequate dimensions required
- ix Library should be provided in an adequate room size and in any case not less than the prescribed dimension as per the CBSE byelaws 2018.
- x Multipurpose hall is missing and it is mandatory to provide either a multipurpose hall or three rooms in adequate dimension for Art, Music and craft. Hence it is imperative on the part of the management to mandatorily provide the above provisions as per the CBSE byelaws 2018.
- xi Maths lab should be established as per the CBSE byelaws 2018.
- xii Boys toilet construction is not yet completed in first floor. Toilet facilities for Boys and Girls should be enhanced in accordance with its enrolment capacity and the existing toilets should be maintained clean and tidy.
- xiii An Elevated wall like steel structure should also be having stability certificate.
- xiv The Educational Agency / School shall abide by the provisions contained in the Tamil Nadu schools(Regulation of collection of fees)Act,2009and rules made there under
- xv The School management should ensure that all teachers are appointed with appropriate educational qualification for teaching as per CBSE affiliation Bye Laws 2018.
- xvi Salary Should be disbursed to the staff on par with the Norms of State Government Pay Commission and should be made only through ECS mode. EPF should also be extended to all eligible staff.
- xvii Copy of Fee fixation order should be displayed in School Notice Board Permanently.
- xviii Compliance of fixing Safety Box regarding child abuse along with awareness posters suggested by the School Education Department affixed in a prominent place should be strictly adhered. The Jurisdictional all Woman Police Station Phone Numbers should be displayed in School Notice Board. Student Safeguarding Advisory Committee constituted in the school vide G.O.(1D) No.83 SED dated 17.06.2021 should effectively redress any issues pertaining to child safety.
- xix School Evacuation Plan, Electrical safety audit, Annual Fire safety drill and all other safety parameters should be satisfied as envisaged in school safety policy 2016.
- xx Complaint committee (Vishaka committee) details with Phone Number should be displayed in the Notice Board.
- xxi CWSN Toilet should be constructed within a span of one month: Ramp with hand rails should be in place for the easy access of PWD and a photo copy of the same should be submitted too this office.
- xxii Rain Water harvesting structure should be established for every building and a photo copy of it should be produced within a month.
- xxiii Proper sewage disposal mechanism should be in place in accordance with the regulations of Tamil Nadu Pollution Control Board and duly certified as well.

xxiv School should update all relevant particulars then and there in their EMIS Portal.

- (26) Points raised in S.No.25 should be complied forthwith and report regarding the same should be submitted to this office immediately and if it is not complied by the school management in all seriousness within a reasonable span of time the renewal of recognition accorded now will be reconsidered and suitable action will be initiated for noncompliance
- (27) The school management should be strictly adhering to the government orders and standard operating procedures issued in relation to prevent the spread of COVID-19 pandemic
